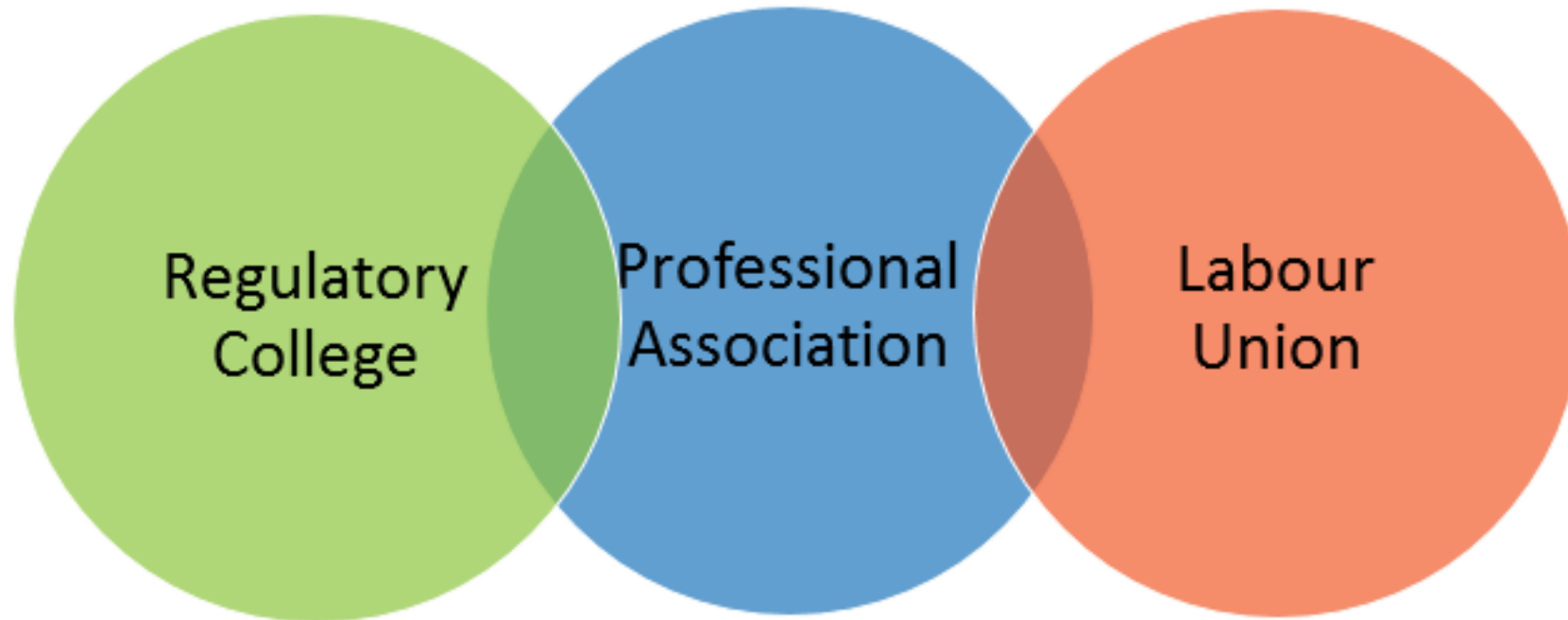

BCCNP Mandate

Legal obligation to **protect the public** by effectively regulating registered nurses, nurse practitioners, licensed practical nurses, and registered psychiatric nurses.

- Sets requirements for entry into profession
- Sets standards for professional practice and ethics
- Sets requirements for maintaining registration
- Investigates and addresses complaints about registrants

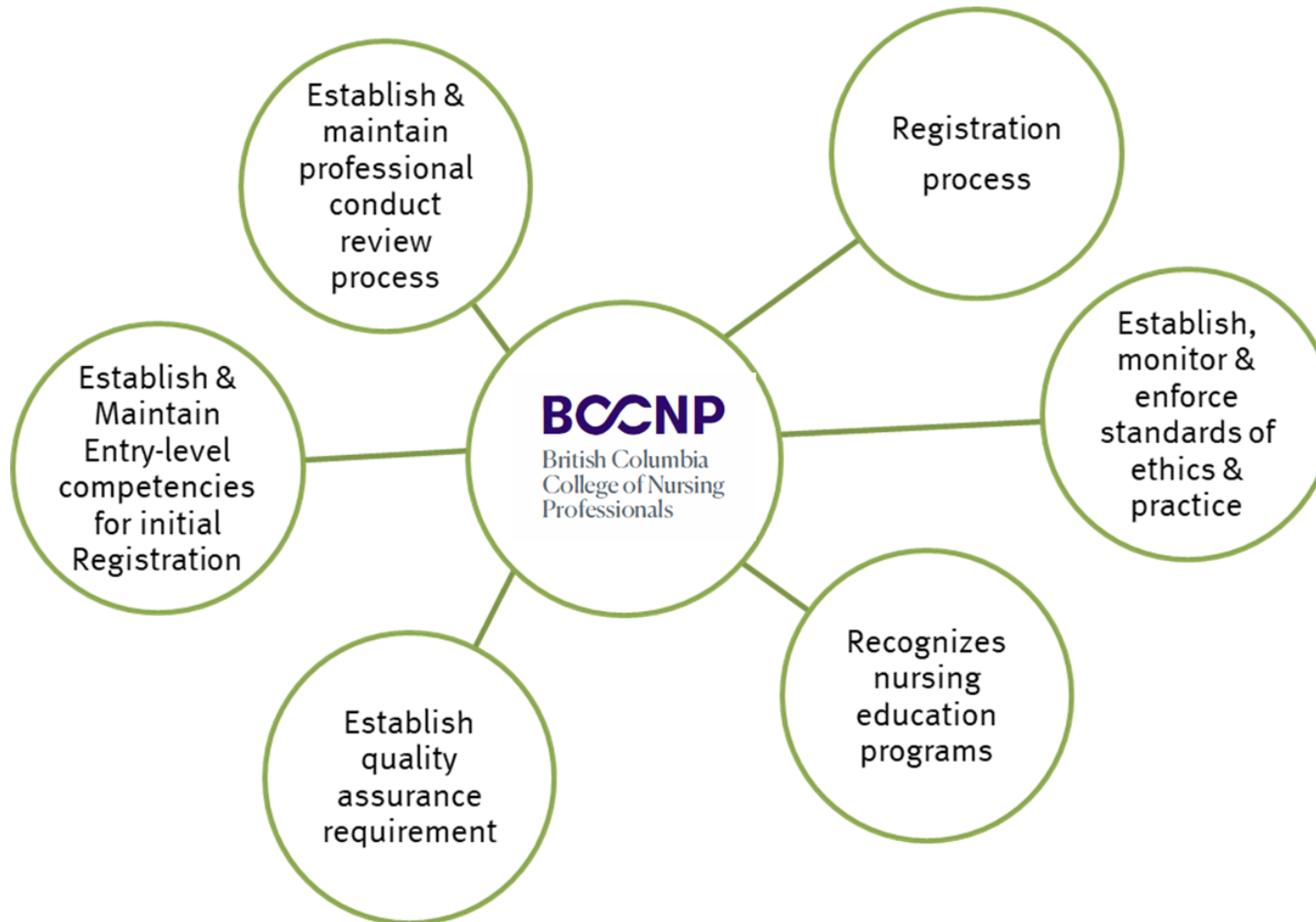

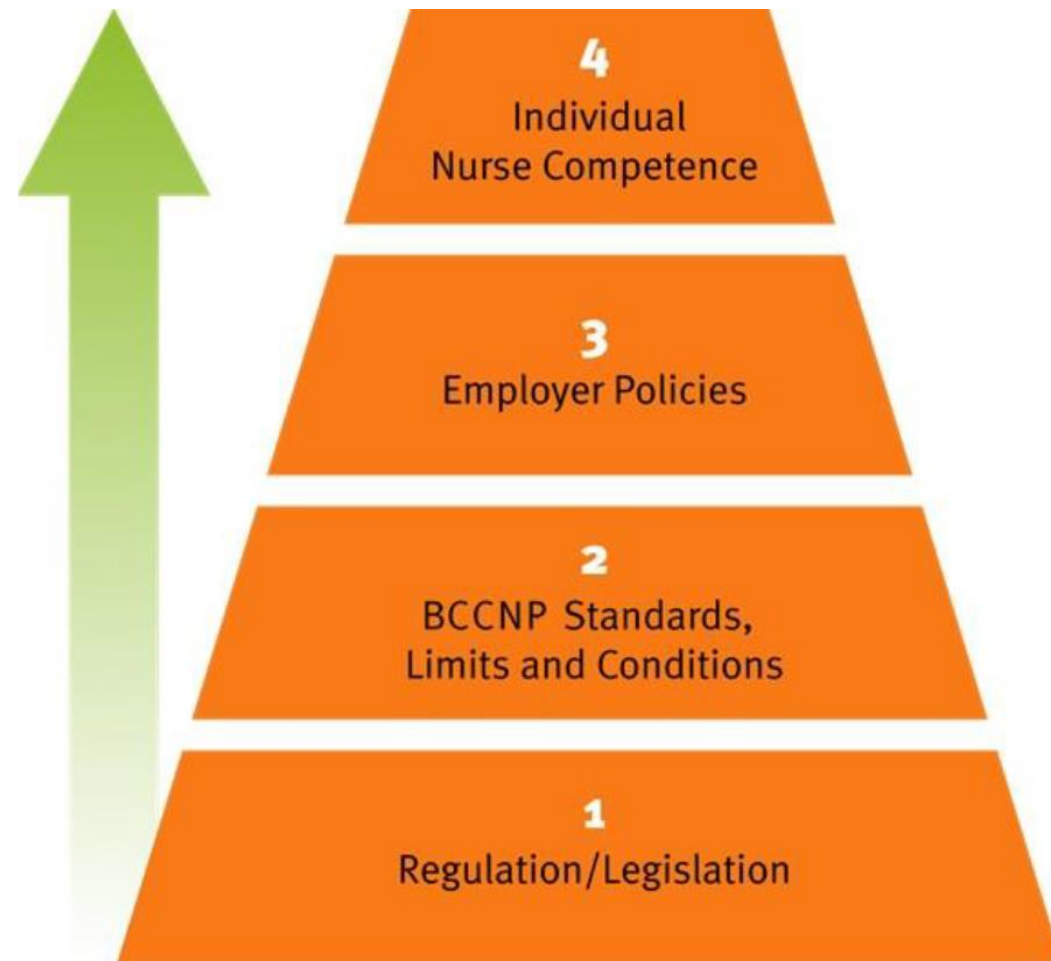

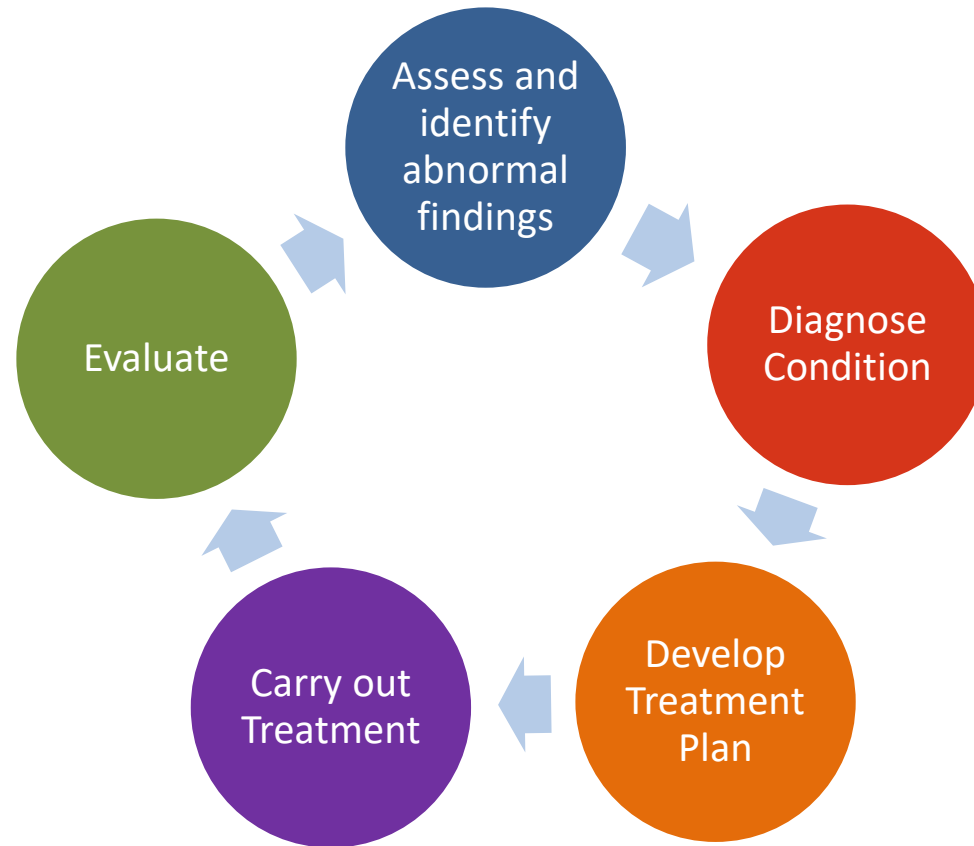
